STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. **THE BIBLE:** The only divinely inspired and infallible Word of God, our final authority in all matters of faith, conduct, and truth (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20-21).
2. **THE ONE TRUE GOD:** Existing eternally as three persons - the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit (Luke 3:22; Matthew 28:19; II Corinthians 13:14).
3. **THE LORD JESUS CHRIST:** His pre-existence and deity (John 1:1-3), incarnate by virgin birth (John 1:14; Matthew 1:18-23), sinless life (Hebrews 4:15), substitutionary death (II Corinthians 5:21), bodily resurrection (Luke 24:36-43), ascension into heaven and present ministry (Hebrews 4:14-16), and coming again (Acts 1:11).
4. **THE HOLY SPIRIT:** His personality (John 16:7-15) and deity (Acts 5:3-4), and His work in each believer (Romans 8:9), and filling (Ephesians 5:18) to empower for Christian life and service (Ephesians 3:16), Acts 1:8, Galatians 5:22-23).
5. **MAN:** His creation in the image of God (Genesis 1:26-28), but man sinned and all are sinners (Romans 3:23), in need of salvation (John 3:3-5).
6. **SALVATION:** We are saved by grace of God, received as the gift of God through personal faith in Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:8-9), we come repenting of our sins, confessing Him as Lord before men, and receiving baptism into Him (Matthew 16:16; Acts 2:38; Acts 8; Acts 16; Romans 10:10).
7. **THE CHURCH:** The Church is the body and bride of Christ (Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:25-32), composed of all believers (I Corinthians 12:12-13), growing together in fellowship and ministry (Ephesians 4:11-16, Acts 2).
8. **CHRISTIAN LIFE:** A lifestyle that strives for righteousness, good works and separation unto God from the evil ways of the world (Romans 12:1-2), manifested by speaking the truth (James 5:12), maintaining the sanctity of the home (Ephesians 5:22, 6:4), settling differences between Christians in accordance with the Word of God (I Corinthians 6:1-8), exhibiting the fruit of the spirit (Galatians 5:22-23), and maintaining a life of prayer (Ephesians 6:18; Philippians 4:6).
9. **ORDINANCES:** The Christian should observe the ordinances of our Lord, which are 1) baptism of believers by immersion (Matthew 28:19; Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; Romans 6:1-6) and 2) the Lord's Supper (I Corinthians 11:20-34; Acts 2:42; Acts 20:7).
10. **SATAN:** His existence and personality as the great adversary of God and His people (Revelation 12:1-10), his judgement (John 12:31), and final doom (Revelation 20:10).
11. **FUTURE LIFE:** The conscious existence of the dead (Philippians 1:21-23; Luke 16:19-31), the resurrection of the body (John 5:28-29), the judgement and reward of believers (Romans 14:10-12; II Corinthians 5:10), the judgement and condemnation of unbelievers (Revelation 20:11-15), the eternal life of the saved (John 3:16), and the eternal punishment of the lost (Matthew 25:46; Revelation 20:15).

CHRISTIAN PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION OF TREE OF LIFE CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS

A Christian Philosophy of Education calls for an educational process that puts the Bible at the center and asks the student to evaluate all he/she studies through the lens of God’s Word. Because God is Truth, He brings a unity of truth to all of his creation. No subject can be taught in its totality if the Creator is ignored or denied.

“Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’” (John 14:6)

“... all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.” (Colossians 1:15-17; 16b-17)

“All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work.” (II Timothy 3:14-17; 16-17)

Christian education elicits learning that is integrated with the eternal rather than segmented and temporal. Knowledge becomes purified by the recognition of God’s place in it; emerging from such knowledge comes wisdom.

“For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding...” (Proverbs 2:6)

“Wisdom is a tree of life to those who take hold of her.” (Proverbs 3:18)

In addition to an integrated approach to knowledge, a Christian philosophy of education calls for the whole child to be educated for life – spiritually, mentally, socially, and physically. Jesus admonished His disciples, *“Permit the little children to come to me for of such is the Kingdom of heaven.” (Matt. 18:3)* In Christian schools, students can come to know Jesus on a daily basis, as they are disciplined as complete creations in Him. Spiritual mentoring and modeling, godly self-discipline and Christ-like expectations of how to treat one another can be woven into the fabric of each child’s life.

“... You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind... You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” (Matthew 22:37- 40; 37,39)

“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.” (Ephesians 2:10)

The Word of God is clear in making parents responsible for the education of their children. *“You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.” (Deut. 6:4-9;7)* In entrusting the church and school to help them in this task, parents rightly ask, “What is to be the end result of learning?” John Milton, in 1644 wisely answered, “The end, then, of learning is to repair the ruins of our first parents by regaining to know God aright, and out of that knowledge to love Him, imitate Him, to be like Him.”
